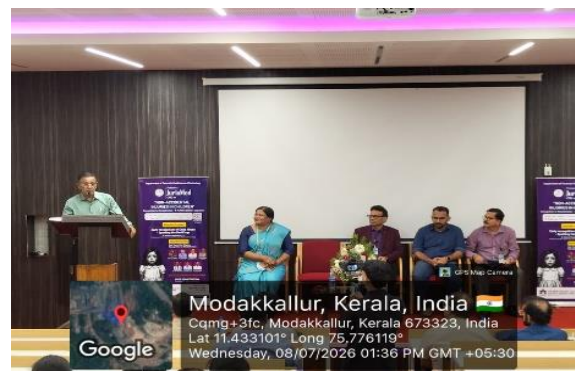
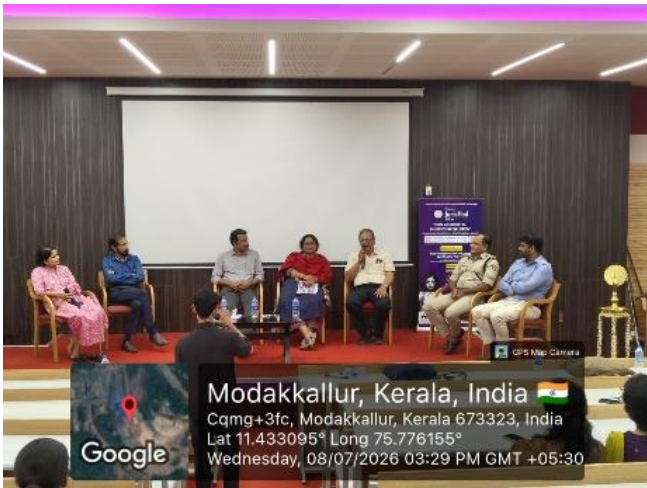
The Department of Forensic Medicine and Toxicology organized a CME focusing on the recognition, documentation, reporting, management and rehabilitation of children subjected to physical abuse. The scientific session included a talk by Dr Neena Priyadarshini A V on the “**Early Recognition of Child Abuse: Spotting the Red Flags**”, followed by a **multidisciplinary panel discussion** involving experts from forensic medicine, law, child welfare, police services, emergency medicine, paediatrics and psychiatry.

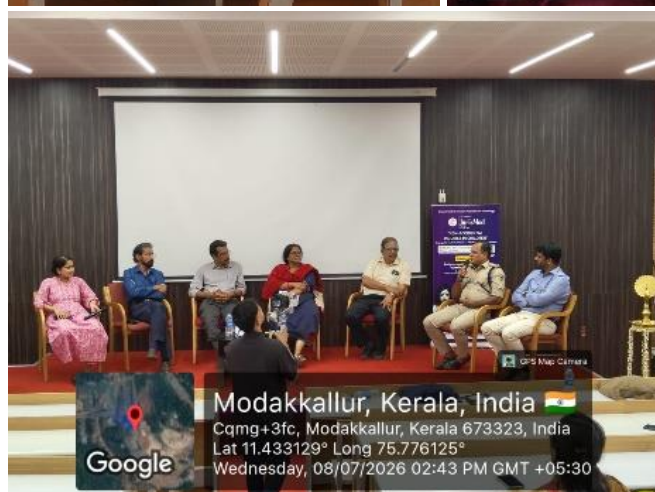
Objective:

- To sensitise healthcare professionals to the early recognition of child abuse and its warning signs.
- To highlight the importance of proper documentation, reporting and timely intervention.
- To promote a multidisciplinary approach to the management and rehabilitation of abused children.
- To strengthen coordination among healthcare, legal, law-enforcement, child-protection and mental-health professionals.

Outcome:

The CME enhanced awareness regarding the identification and appropriate handling of suspected child abuse. The interactive panel discussion provided insights into the medico-legal, clinical, psychosocial and child-protection aspects of these cases. The programme emphasized the importance of **early recognition, sensitive management, proper documentation, timely reporting and coordinated multidisciplinary care** to ensure the safety, protection and holistic rehabilitation of affected children.
