HOSTEL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Hostlers will not be permitted to go out after 7.00 p.m.

- 2. Jewels, costly articles and heavy cash etc. should not be kept in their room. The management holds no responsibility of damage or loss of such items.
- 3. Parents / Guardians are permitted to meet the students at hostel once in a month between 4 pm and 6 pm.
- 4. If the parents want to take their ward for outing, prior permission of the hostel warden / Principal should be obtained.
- 5. Rooms should always be kept neat and tidy.
- 6. Viewing CDs, playing tape recorders in the rooms are prohibited.
- 7. Smoking is strictly prohibited. Severe action will be taken, if usages of alcohol or drugs in the rooms by the students are noticed.
- 8. No outsiders and day scholars will be allowed to visit the students in the hostel.
- 9. No guest will be allowed to stay in the hostel.
- 10.No inconvenience or disturbance to be created to the roommate.
- 11. Hostlers will not be permitted to leave the Headquarters without prior permission of the Authority competent to sign their permission letter. Any violation will lead to strict disciplinary action.
- 12. Usage of Cell Phone during study hours is strictly prohibited.
- 13. Usage of kettles and other high voltage equipment's inside the rooms is strictly prohibited. If found all occupants of the room will have to pay huge fine and such items will be confiscated.
- 14. Hostel & Mess Fee will not be refunded if the candidate vacates the hostel at their own reasons in the midst of academic year. Only caution money deposit will be refunded based on the No Due Certificate from Hostel wardens.
- 15. Regular inspection of the hostel rooms and premises will be conducted by the college authorities. Appropriate disciplinary action will be initiated against all occupants of the rooms which are not kept neat and tidy, walls with graffiti and or found damaged in any manner.
- 16. Appropriate disciplinary action will be initiated against all occupants of the rooms / floor if equipment's / property of any kind is found damaged, for unauthorized use of fire extinguishers etc.
- 17. Routine cleaning of the common spaces and disbursal of the waste (waste generation inside the room should be avoided) from the rooms will be done regular by the housekeeping staff. However, it will the responsibility of the hostler to ensure that these spaces are kept neat and tidy, and particularly the rooms allotted to them.
