MANANCHIRA SQUARE

A 3.49 acres man-made freshwater pond park situated in the centre of the city of Kozhikode town.
Mananchira was built as a bathing pool by the Zamorin Mana Vikrama, the feudal ruler of Kozhikode in around the 14th century.

SM STREET (MITHAI THERUVU)

The legendary Sweet Meat Street or Mithai Theruvu is the go-to place for such delicacies in Kozhikode district. Named from the times when the street was lined with sweet-meat (halwa) stalls.

SARGAALAYA KERALA ARTS & CRAFTS VILLAGE

an initiative by the Department of Tourism, Government of Kerala. The Village is a craft cluster that was conceptualized as a tourism destination, developed and implemented on the Responsible Tourism model.

THUSHARAGIRI WATERFALLS

Caressed in the folds of the Western Ghats is this picturesque waterfall. The Thusharagiri Waterfalls comprises Erattumukku, Mazhavil Chattom, and Thumbithullum Para which can be reached through trekking.

From MMC- 42 km From Kozhikode Town -51 km





ARIPPARA WATERFALLS

The mighty Iruvanji river cascades down the rocky hills to form the gorgeous Arippara waterfalls. This is an eight-level waterfall with Sullukallu, Vattakkuzhi, Nirannapara, Olichuchaattom, Shwasakkuzhi and Neelakkayathadaakam as its companions.

DISTANCE

from MMC- 44 km; from Kozhikode Town- 43 km

KAKKAYAM DAM

Kakkayam is on the outskirts of the Western Ghats, and Malabar Wildlife Sanctuary, a 7,421-hectare abode of wild animals including elephants and bisons. Kakkayam has an abundant wildlife population and is also a trekking and rock climbing destination.
