- ❖ On day2, the sessions on "Selection of appropriate statistical tests", "hands on training on tests of significance", "basics of regression", "hands on training on regression" and "Key concepts in diagnostic test validation- part 1" was covered forenoon and the sessions on "Key concepts in diagnostic test validation- part 2", "Hands on training on diagnostic test validation" was covered in the afternoon. This was followed by an interactive doubt clearing session.
