### ORDER

1) Vide notification read (1) above, University had invited application for starting/enhancement of UG/PG courses for the academic year 2024-25. The Chairman, Malabar Medical College Hospital and Research Centre, Kozhikode under Sree Anjaneya Medical Trust vide paper read (2) above, submitted application for starting B.Sc Anaesthesia Technology course for the academic year 2024-25.

2) The college has submitted NOC from Govt.of Kerala, vide paper (3) above, for starting B.Sc Anaesthesia Technology course with 20 seats.

3) Accordingly, the University conducted inspection at the college. After verifying the inspection report, the Scrutiny Committee pointed out certain deficiencies and recommended to grant Provisional Affiliation for starting B.Sc Anaesthesia Technology course with 5 seats, the same were intimated to the college for rectification.

4) Upon verification of the subsequent compliance reports submitted by the college, the Scrutiny Committee has observed that the existing facilities in the college are sufficient to conduct B.Sc Anaesthesia Technology course with 6 seats and recommended to grant Provisional Affiliation for starting B.Sc Anaesthesia Technology course with 6 seats for the academic year 2024-25 at Malabar Medical College Hospital and Research Centre, Kozhikode.

5) Based on the request from the college for reconsideration of application for starting B.Sc Anaesthesia Technology 20 seats, a re-scrutiny of all documents was carried out. The committee reported the following:

The primary goal of this four-year undergraduate program is to equip students with the skills and expertise necessary to assist Anaesthesiologists in handling patients in operating rooms(OR) and intensive care units(ICU). Hence to ensure effective training and patient safety we need to provide them with one-one instruction and extensive hands on training over four years. It should be noted that the number of students will multiply by 4 (and may be 5 if there is a compulsory internship of one year) over the course period. As per auidelines of various international societies (ASPAN, AORN, WHO, SCCM, AHA, CDC etc.), it is essential to restrict number of personnel in OR and ICU for considerations of

infection control risk, patient confidentiality, space constraints, equipment sterility and staff safety inversity@gmail.com

Given the courses inaugural launch in Kerala, recommend capping the initial intake at 6 students to enable effective resource utilization, optimal student to instructor ratio and enhanced training quality. After four years when the first batch completes the program, totaling in 24 students, the course effectiveness will be assessed. This review will consider training quality, infrastructure utilization and manpower deployment. Based on this evaluation seat allocation may be either reduced, if standards are not met, or increased, if the program demonstrates capacity for growth.

6) In the meantime, taking into consideration the above facts and examining the matter in detail, the university decided to reduce the admission capacity of B.Sc Anaesthesia Technology course as 6-10 seats depending upon the availability of infrastructure and faculty vide UO read (5) above.

7) The whole matter was placed before the Subcommittee of the Governing Council and vide paper read (6) above, the Subcommittee recommended to grant Provisional Affiliation for starting B.Sc Anaesthesia Technology course with 6 seats for the academic year 2024-25 at Malabar Medical College Hospital and Research Centre,Kozhikode.8) Based on GC Decision read (7) above,the University had directed all the affiliated colleges to submit in the specific format as given by the University regarding the payment of GST and the college has submitted the same.

10) The college has remitted requisite amount of the affiliation fee and refundable deposit.

11) In the circumstances, Considering that the admission process to Allied Health Sciences courses is going on and also based on the recommendations of subcommittee of Governing Council, sanction is hereby accorded to grant Provisional Affiliation to Malabar Medical College Hospital and Research Centre,Kozhikode for starting B.Sc Anaesthesia Technology with an intake of 6 seats for the academic year 2024-25 subject to ratification by the Governing Council.

The college shall strictly adhere to the following conditions:

- Selection, admission and collection of fees shall be made only on the basis of the rules and regulations of the University/Govt. of Kerala and on the basis of the direction issued by the University from time to time, failing which the affiliation granted will be cancelled.
- In the light of the direction of the Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition (c) 656/1998, the institution shall takeappropriate measures for prevention of ragging in any form. In case of failure to prevent the instances of ragging, appropriate action including withdrawal of affiliation of the College will be initiated.
- Affiliation granted is strictly provisional and only for the academic year 2024-25. The college has to apply for Continuation of Provisional Affiliation for the ensuing years remitting the fee fixed by the University.
- The college should remit the annual administration fee fixed for UG course for the academic year 2024-25.
- Admission to the next academic year shall be made only after obtaining prior permission from the University.
- The college should collect fees (One time payment at the time of admission) from the students to be remitted to this University as follows:
