WHEREAS, "SAMT" is a medical trust with various institutions established in Kozhikode is interested in developing collaboration with "MVRCCRI" for the purpose of Clinical research for Cancer Research programme.

WHEREAS, "MVRCCRI", is a Tertiary Cancer hospital and Research Centre interested in collaborating with GMC in Cancer research.

WHEREAS, "SAMT" and "MVRCCRI" recognize that research collaboration would be of mutual benefit and would help in strengthening research in one another's research areas.

WHEREAS, this Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") will establish a mechanism for the "SAMT" and "MVRCCRI", here after collectively referred as "Institutions" to plan collaborative research activities; and

WHEREAS, each Party to this MOU recognizes the unique expertise of the other; and

NOW THEREFORE, the Institutions agree as follows:

II. AUTHORITIES

"SAMT" and "MVRCCRI" represent that they are each authorized under the laws of the constitution of India to enter into an MOU where such MOU promotes their objectives and mission.

III. OBJECTIVES

The objectives of this MOU are:

- To allow the "Institutions" to plan collaborative research and training activities in the areas of Cancer research.
- 2. To undertake clinical research under the scheme of Department of Science & technology, Government of India.

IV. ACTIVITIES

In furtherance of the above objectives, the "Institutions" agree that each will do thefollowing:

- 1. The Dean & Director of "Sree Anjaneya Institute of Dental Sciences (SAIDS)" willserve as a project coordinator to assist in developing and planning collaborative research projects.
- 2. The "Institutions" will carry out research activities, as per this Memorandum of Understanding. The activities must be carried out in accordance with appropriate laws and regulations existing in the country and in the institutions.
- 3. This MOU is specifically for SAMT, Kozhikode, whereas the parent institute will be SAMT and the required budget for "MVRCCRI" will be disbursed by SAMT from the fund sanctioned by, SAMT, Kozhikode as per the terms and conditions of the scheme.
- 4. The research agreement arising from this MOU will include, provisions setting forththe approved budget, a description of the scope of work to be performed, providing appropriate training for research fellows/investigators.
- 5. This MOU is specifically for the collaborative research activities of Cancer Research and does not claim any collaboration with other research areas of SAMT, Calicut

IV. I Role SAMT

- 1. To deliver the paid clinical services for the patients from MVRCCRI 2. To Conduct the collaborative research in various fields of oncology
- 2. To be responsible for all kinds of academic activities (Ph.D research, MDS and BDS thesis) carried out by the students from the associated institutions of SAMT
- 3. To ensure the co-authorship of co investigators from MVRCCRI in the publications of the collaborative academic/research projects
- 4. To Conduct joint workshops and conferences in the combined areas of interest

IV. II Role of MVRCCRI

- 1. To guide the entire academic and research proposals from SAMT with MVRCCRI to do the Research committee approvals (both institute Review board and Institute Ethics committee).
- 2. Guidance in proposal development and data collection of the academic projects.
- 3. Ensure the payments associated with project approval (Institute Ethics Committee fees and academic fee) and project implementation
- 4. Conduct joint workshops and conferences in the combined areas of interest
- 5. Student and staff exchange programme as a part of the undergraduate and Post Graduate training

V. CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

Confidential information means all oral, written, graphic or physical information, formula, research data, know-how and trade secrets. All such confidential information will be the exclusive property of respective Institutions. Both the Institutions agreethat, they will not use such confidential information for any other purpose without the prior

NONDISCRIMINATION IN EMPLOYMENT VI.

In connection with the performance of work under this MOU, the "Institutions" agree not to discriminate against any employee, student, or applicant for employment because of sex, race, religion, color or handicap.

AMENDMENTS AND REVIEW VII.

The terms of this MOU may be amended only by written mutual agreement and the amendment will be effective when signed by the "Institutions".

VIII. TERM AND TERMINATION

This MOU shall be in effect from the date of signature and will be valid up to five years or till the end of Medical council of India project whichever is earlier and can be renewed further upon mutual approval by executing a fresh agreement.

IX. DISPUTE REDRESSAL

Any dispute or differences or claims arising out of this agreement shall be settled between the Institutions through mutual discussion and in the absence of an amicable settlement will be referred to mutually agreed arbitrator appointed by the Institutions jointly. The venue of arbitration will be Kozhikode, Kerala.
